WINE SELECTION

RED WINES:

Loukatos Mavrodaphne: Sweet, fruity red wine. Made from 100% Mavrodaphne, meaning black laurel, is mainly found in the Peloponnesian regions of Achaia and Ilia as well as the Ionian Islands. It is blended with the Korinthiaki grape to produce a delicious fortified dessert wine, known as Mavrodaphne. Toasted nut, cedar and cigar box aromas give this lush dessert wine an earthy feel. On the palate, dried nuts and fruit flavors and a spicy finish entice. Pair with nuts, cheeses, fruit.

ANEMOS RED:

Red Dry Wine

Protected Geographical Indication (PGI) Peloponnese

Tasting notes: A deep-colored purple wine with intense fruity and clean aromas and the dominated flavors of cherries, strawberries and gooseberries. The silky mouth feel and the grape juice aftertaste give the impression that you are tasting grapes from the vineyard during September.

WHITE WINES:

Omikron Retsina: A fresh and crisp wine with a mentholly taste and aroma derived from pine resin added during fermentation. A traditional wine dating to Ancient Greece. Light as air, this is all about the refreshing menthol qualities of pine. Chill it well and drink with salty foods. Best when accompanied with Mediterranean or Asian seafood dishes. ANEMOS WHITE:

White Dry Wine

Protected Geographican Indication (PGI) Peloponnese

Tasting notes: A fruity wine with aromas and flavors of fresh fruits: apples, bananas, pears, pineapple and lemon blossoms. Pleasant and balanced wine with light body, refreshing acidity and fruity aftertaste.

Metaxa Ouzo Liqueur:

In the early 1900s, the Metaxa distillery was in Piraeus and, like other distilleries of the time, created different styles of alcoholic drinks. Among them, the most popular Greek aperitif: Ouzo. OUZO by METAXA is based on the original recipe of that time, which includes different aromatic seeds of the Mediterranean basin and the rare mastic of Chios island.

Metaxa 5 Star Brandy:

Metaxa is a Greek Brown spirit created by Spyros Metaxas in 1888. It is a blend of wine distillates, Muscat wines and a secret bouquet of rose petals and Mediterranean herbs. It is exported to over 65 countries and was the first liquor consumed in space. Metaxi literally means "silk," with "Metaxas" being a common Greek family name.
